



Preschool Teacher Qualifications:

1. Be active in your Christian faith.
2. Have a degree in Early Education (or other experiential evidence).
3. Be able to plan a curriculum for the school year.
4. Be able to communicate well with parents, including
 - Newsletters to parents
 - Snack schedules
 - Field trips for 4's
5. Be willing and able to work with the parents as well as the children for the wellbeing of the whole family.
6. Be willing to work with the church staff on scheduling and sharing spaces.
7. Be willing to work outside of scheduled time in the classroom.
 - Preparation time
 - Field trips
8. Be willing to purchase your own supplies for the year and then be reimbursed.
9. Keep track of your own budget and what you have spent.
10. Be able to keep conversations with parents confidential.
11. Be able to make the classroom environment appealing and stimulating to young children.
12. Be willing to submit to the lead pastor or preschool administrator if there is a decision that needs to be made.
13. Be able to handle a classroom of 10 children with love, encouragement and patience.
14. Be willing to be observed by the preschool administrator.
15. Be willing to do your own cleaning except for vacuuming and bathrooms.
16. Read and follow the Child and Youth Protection Manual.
17. Pass a criminal background check.
18. Have a current CPR and First Aid card.
19. Be prepared to teach with hands-on activities.
